

Title XLVII. Criminal Procedure and Corrections (Chapters 900-999) (Refs & Annos)

Chapter 951. County and Municipal Prisoners (Refs & Annos)

West's F.S.A. § 951.06

951.06. Employment of correctional officers; duties; salary

Currentness

- (1) The county commissioners shall designate a chief correctional officer and such correctional officers as they deem necessary.
- (2) All chief correctional officers of prisoners shall see that all rules and regulations prescribed by law or the department are fully observed and complied with; enforce discipline among the prisoners in and about the camps; and administer punishment to prisoners, when in their judgment the same is necessary in order to enforce proper discipline, conforming always to the law and rules and regulations.
- (3) All boards of county commissioners shall immediately discharge any correctional officer who shall be guilty of gross negligence or cruel and inhuman treatment of prisoners under their control and their action shall be final.
- (4) The salaries of correctional officers provided for in this chapter shall be fixed by the board of county commissioners, and the chief correctional officer shall be furnished means of transportation over the roads of the county when necessary, the upkeep and operation of which shall be furnished by the county; however, the county shall not in any case be required to furnish a driver of such conveyance where such services are required to be paid for.
- (5) All salaries contemplated by this chapter shall be paid from the general revenue fund of the county.


Dear Northwest Florida Coastal Partner:

Re: Actuarial Valuation of Postretirement Benefits under GASB 45 for Gulf County, Florida

Pursuant to your request, we have completed an actuarial valuation of the benefit cost and funded status relating to the future retiree medical benefits provided by Gulf County, Florida for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010. The results of our calculations are set forth in the following report, as are the actuarial assumptions, methods and brief summary of the retiree eligibility and benefits upon which our calculations have been made. Our determinations reflect the procedures and methods as prescribed in Statement 45 of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, "Accounting and Financial Reporting by Employers for Postemployment Benefits Other than Pensions" ("Statement").

Actuarial computations under the Statement are for purposes of fulfilling certain employer accounting requirements. The calculations reported herein have been made on a basis consistent with our understanding of the Statement. Determinations for purposes other than meeting the employer financial accounting requirements of the Statement may differ significantly from the results reported herein.

In preparing our calculations for this report, we have relied without audit, on the employee data, plan provisions, and other plan financial information as provided by Gulf County, Florida. The census data was collected as of July 2011. If any of this information, as summarized in this report, is inaccurate or incomplete, the results shown could be materially affected and this report may need to be revised. If there are material defects in the data, it is possible that they would be uncovered by a detailed, systematic review and comparison of the data to search for data values that are questionable or for relationships that are materially inconsistent. Such a review was beyond the scope of our assignment.

This report may not be used without Milliman's prior written consent. If this report is distributed to other parties, it must be copied in its entirety including this section. We understand that the plan sponsor may distribute this report to its auditor in connection with its audit. We will consent to this distribution as long as the work is distributed in its entirety, and the auditor is advised to have an actuary review the work. Milliman does not intend to benefit any third party recipient of its work product, including the auditor, and does not intend to create any legal duty from Milliman to the auditor even if Milliman consents to the release of its work product. In the event that the auditor's audit reveals any error or inaccuracy in the data underlying the report, Milliman requests that the auditor or the plan sponsor notify Milliman as soon as possible.

On the basis of the foregoing, we hereby certify that, to the best of our knowledge and belief, this report is complete and accurate and has been prepared in accordance with generally recognized and accepted actuarial principles and practices which are consistent with the applicable Actuarial Standards of Practice.


We further certify that, in our opinion, each actuarial assumption, method and technique used is individually reasonable taking into account the experience of the Plan and reasonable expectations. Nevertheless, the emerging liabilities and costs of the plan will vary from those presented in this report to the extent that actual experience differs from that projected by the actuarial assumptions.

Future actuarial measurements may differ significantly from the current measurements presented in this report due to such factors as the following: plan experience differing from that anticipated by the economic or demographic assumptions; changes in economic or demographic assumptions; increases or decreases expected as part of the natural operation of the methodology used for these measurements (such as the end of an amortization period or additional cost or contribution requirements based on the plan's funded status); and changes in plan provisions or applicable law. Due to the limited scope of our assignment, we did not perform an analysis of the potential range of future measurements.

We are members of the American Academy of Actuaries and meet the Qualification Standards of the American Academy of Actuaries to render the actuarial opinion contained herein.
