I am pleased to award Gulf County state emergency medical services (EMS) county grant ID Code C1023 for \$1,637.00. You should receive the full amount in advance within 30 days. The purpose of this grant is to improve and expand pre-hospital EMS.

Paragraph 401.113(2) (a), *Florida Statutes*, authorizes and requires this grant program, which is number 64.005 in the *Florida Catalog of State Financial Assistance*. The money is state funds from the Department of Health's EMS Trust Fund and there are no federal funds involved.


Re: Truth in Millage (TRIM) Certification


Re: Maximum Millage Levy Calculation Final Disclosure

Based on the documents submitted for all these entities, the Department has determined that your taxing authority is in compliance with the maximum total taxes levied requirements, and thus the maximum millage levy requirements, of s. 200.065(5), Florida Statutes.
