Well AAA2250 is in close proximity to St. Joseph Bay. It was damaged during the demolition of the old primary lift station in August 2012. In the event of a Hurricane and flooding of that area, the well is susceptible to Salt Water Intrusion into the Florida Aquifer. This could possibly contaminate the entire Aquifer. The damaged well was only temporarily capped until funds to properly abandon the well could be obtained.

Approximately \$35,000 for abandonment of both wells.
